SWIFT SA values and respects your privacy and that is why we would like to reassure you that we are committed to keeping your personal information, as well as any personal information collected from you, secure and confidential.

The *Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA)* came into effect on the 1st of July 2021. This act requires that we obtain your consent to communicate with you in the future. The said communication could be in the form of news, updates on any event or opportunity that SWIFT SA might have.

If you are happy to keep receiving emails from us there is no need to do anything. However should you change your mind at any time in the future, an unsubscribe link will be found in our emails or you can simply communicate about your wish for the communication to discontinue.

Privacy Policy (Use of your information)

The information given to us with your consent can and will be accessed by relevant employees of SWIFT SA. This information is kept in our cloud storage, which can be accessed by the board members and staff who have been granted permission. To ensure these parties keep the information accessed confidential, a confidentiality clause has been made part of their agreement upon taking on duties.

You can request access to the information we hold about you at any time and if you think that we have outdated information, please request for us to update or correct it. You can also ask for the information to be deleted at any time.

What is POPIA?

POPIA is an act put in place in South Africa with the intention of protecting your personal information and privacy. Most organisations these days are collecting personally identifiable data to run their businesses, it is therefore important that the way data is being processed is regulated by a governing body. SWIFT SA therefore fully supports POPIA and the need for the conditions set out therein.
